The extinct trigonotarbid arachnid *Eophrynus prestvicii* (Lapworth Museum, specimen no. BU 699) reconstructed as a three-dimensional model using X-ray micro-tomography. Essentially, the void in the siderite matrix which contained the original animal has been scanned here. The video shows the entire animal, including details of the limbs and the spines and tubercles ornamenting the body, which are difficult to resolve using traditional methods of study.
