

Restudy of a 19-th-century dinoflagellate cyst hoiotype from the Polish Upper Jurassic

Results are presented of a re-examination of the holotype of *Xanthidium penicillatum*, a species of dinoflagellate cyst first reported by Ehrenberg (1843) from the Corallian of Poland and validly published by him in 1854. It is shown to correspond exactly in morphology with *Systematophora fascicutigera* (Klement, 1960), from the Upper Jurassic of Germany. The new combination *Systematophora penicillata* (Ehrenberg, 1854) is proposed and *S. fasciculigera* is rejected as a subjective junior synonym.
