

## Les Radiolaires du Campanien inferieur de Cracovie (Pologne)

Lower Campanian Radiolarians (Polycystina) from outcrops at Cracow (southern Poland) are very abundant and very well preserved. Fifty species amongst spumellarians et nasselarians are described. One genus, *Vistularia*, and four species are new: *Archaeospongoprimum cracoviense* sp. n., *Pseudoaulophacus polonicus* sp. n., *Pseudoaulophacus vistulae* sp. n., and *Vistularia magna* gen. et sp. n.
