

Machairodus sp. from the Lower Pliocene bone breccia of Weże (Poland)

First record of *Machairodus* from Poland (locality Weże I) is presented. The material, containing three isolated teeth, presumably comes from the oldest sedimentary cycle of the Weże I breccia (5.5-8.0 My). It is the northernmost known locality of *Machairodus* in Europe.
