

On the genus Poloniella Gürich (Ostracoda)

This paper reports the results of investigations on t he ontogeny, variation, dimorphism and structure of carapace in several species of *Poloniella* Gürich (Kloedenellidae) from Middle Devonian strata of the Holy Cross Mountains (Góry Świętokrzyskie) in Poland. *Dizygopleura* Ulrich & Bassler is regarded as a synonym of the genus *Poloniella* Gürich. Two new species: *P. brevis* and *P. diversa* have been distinguished; a description is given of the male specimens of two species, heretofore not recorded from Poland (*P. tertia* Kromrnelbein, *P. cingulata* Warthin), also of two other species (*P. kielanae* Pribyl, *P. devonica* Gürich) previously reported from Poland.
