

Some decapod crustaceans from the Lower Cretaceous of Poland and England

A new species of macrurous crustacean, *Glypheopsis sanctaecrucis*, is represented by two subspecies. The nominal subspecies is described from the Upper Albian of Poland. The other new subspecies, *Glypheopsis sanctaecrucis woodsi*, is described from the Upper Greensand of England. The species *Hoploparia longimana* (G. B. Sowerby) and *Hoploparia* cf. *minima* Tribolet are recorded for the first time from the Upper Valanginian of Poland.
