

Tuboid graptolites from erratic boulders of Poland

Cyclograptidae (= Idiotubidae) are described from the Ordovician to Silurian erratic boulders of Poland. Some problems involved in tuboid taxonomy and colony organization are considered. One new genus (*Kozlowskitubus* gen.n.) and three new species (*Epigraptus eisenacki* sp.n., *E. kozlowskii* sp.n., *Dendrotubus bulmani* sp.n.) are erected. Names Idiotubus Kozlowski, 1949, and Idiotubidae Kozlowski, 1949, were recognized for junior synonyms of *Epigraptus* Eisenack, 1941, and Cyclograptidae Bulman, 1938, respectively.
