

On Pleistocene Amphora thumensis (Mayer) Krieger (Bacillariophyceae)

Light and scanning electron microrscope study of the Eemian frustules of the diatom most frequently identified as *Cymbella thumensis* (Mayer) Hustedt confirms its assignment to the genus *Amphora*. According to the principles of the ICBN (1961) it should be named *A. thumensis* (Mayer) Krieger.
