

Devonian tabulate corals from Western Pomerania, Poland

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Seven species of Tabulata (including three new ones: *Alveolitella pseudoramosa* sp.n., *Syringoporella stasinskae* sp.n., *Sinopora minima* sp.n.) from the Givetian - and Frasnian of the Wyszecbórz 1 borehole, north-western part of Poland has been described and figured. Tabulata occur with other fossils in three rich in fossils horizons of the Wyszecbórz 1 profile.
