

Tochisaurus nemegtensis gen. et sp. n., a new troodontid (dinosauria, theropoda) from Mongolia

A troodontid dinosaur *Tochisaurus nemegtensis* gen. et sp. n., is described. Material consists of a solitary metatarsus from the upper Campanian or lower Maastrichtian Nemegt Formation, southern Gobi, Mongolia. The metatarsus is very slender and has strongly reduced second metatarsal, which implies that the second pedal digit was
