Two Ordovician polychaete jaw apparatuses of a new pattern: *Vistulella kozlowskii* n. gen., n. sp. and *Mochtyella cristata* n. gen., n. sp., from the erratic boulders of Poland, are described and figured. Some questions of scolecodont terminology are discussed.
