

Scleractinia from the Upper Portlandian of Tisbury, Wiltshire, England

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Four species of Scleractinia: *Pseudodiplocoenia oblonga* (Fleming), *Ellipsasteria gracilis* n. gen., n. sp., *Edwardsastraea tisburyensis* n. gen., n. sp. and *Ebrayia dightonthomasi* n. sp., from the uppermost Portlandian of Tisbury, west of Salisbury, Wiltshire, England, are here described. The histological structure of the skeleton of *Pseudodiplocoenia oblonga*, preserved in silicified colonies is presented.

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
