

## **Middle and Upper Vesulian ostracods of the genus *Glyptocythere* brand and malz of the Częstochowa region (Poland)**

Ostracods of the genus *Glyptocythere* Brand and Malz, found in the Kuiavian (= Vesulian) rocks penetrated by the boreholes Jaworzniak, Iwanowice Wielkie and Choron, are described. Two of the five species described - *Glyptocythere posterocostata* and *G. medisulcata* - are new. The intraspecific variability and stratigraphical distribution of particular species are discussed.
