

## A new problematic microfossil from the Eocene of Western Europe

A new problematic microfossil named *Aubertianella keiji* gen. et sp.n. is described from the Lower Eocene (Ilerdlan) of Spain and Lower Eocene (Ypreslan) of Belgium. It Is compared with other problematics, often considered as tintinnids; the systematic position of the discussed forms is revised.
